



Declaration of Conformity TSCA

Revision: July 2024

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), which is the counterpart to the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA), established the rules for Section 6 (h) of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) on January 6, 2021.

This regulation aims to reduce five persistent, bioaccumulative, and toxic chemicals (PBT) and became legally effective in the US in March 2021. Two of the five chemicals are already classified in Europe under REACH / SVHC or POP (as of June 2021). The other three substances have not yet been listed on the ECHA SVHC list.

These substances may not be used in pure form or in mixtures with other products in the USA:

Decabromodiphenyl ether (decaBDE)	CAS 1163-19-5
Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP 3:1)	CAS 68937-41-7
2,4,6-tris (tert-Butyl) phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)	CAS 732-26-3
Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD)	CAS 87-68-3
Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)	CAS 133-49-3
