

Declaration of Conformity to California Proposition (CP) 65

Revision: August 2026

California Proposition 65 is a labeling law known as the "Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986." In 2026, the Proposition 65 list in California includes around 1000 chemicals that are known to be carcinogenic or toxic to reproduction. This list is updated at least once a year. These warnings are widespread in California and are found in many industries, such as food, beverage, and clothing retail.

Although the lists of chemicals in California and the EU overlap in many areas, Prop 65 warnings are not based on exposure limits and do not correlate with the quantity limits specified in EU directives. Since the scope of CP 65 applies exclusively to consumer products with potential personal contact, the KSG Group is not primarily affected, as the products (bare printed circuit boards) are purposefully processed and integrated into other products without the end consumer coming into contact with them during intended use.

This regulation is not mandatory in Germany and the EU, but it has direct impacts on supply chains. Information on substances that require declaration under CP 65 is not fully and directly available in the European Economic Area.

Based on information from our suppliers and their analyses (SVHC substances), the following listed substances may be present in bare printed circuit boards in concentrations of up to a maximum of 0.1 mass percent.
